

#### From Mrs Busari

This week we have our parent information session on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> October from 3.30-4pm. This is an important session to attend where you can learn about how you can support your child at home with their learning. If you have a child in each class, then please head to the phonics talk first and then any additional information can be picked up with the Key Stage Two team.

On Friday 13<sup>th</sup> October we will be celebrating Harvest. This year, we have decided to take the children to the church in Cosgrove for our service. Whilst there the children will be sharing work and contributing to the service as well as listening to key messages around the theme of being thankful. They will sing some Harvest songs and the lay minister will finish with an invitational prayer and blessing for those attending. Children and families are asked if they would like to bring a donation for the harvest offering, to bring it in on the day and carry it to the church to put with the church collection for Milton Keynes Food Bank. Canned produce is usually popular as it is non-perishable. The service will start at 2pm and parents and families are welcome to attend. If you do not wish your child to attend church for the service, please speak to Mrs Busari and we will arrange for them to remain in school. We will give out our weekly celebration awards in the service. The service will last around 45 minutes and then we will return to school ready for home time. We will monitor the forecast carefully throughout the week.

Finally, parents of Year 5 children who have been involved in the TRUST programme, the final meeting is on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> October 4-5pm in the school hall. As previously, children are able to attend and we will arrange supervision for them in the classroom.
